Set the ID application Every Android has a unique ID that looks like a Java package name, such as com.Example.MyApp. This ID uniquely identifies your application on the device and the Google Play Store. If you want to upload a new version of your application, the application ID (and the certificate to sign with) must be the same Original artifact - If you change the application ID, Google Play Store deals with loading as a completely different app. So once your app is published, you should never change the ID of the application. However, the application ID and the package name are independent of each other over this point. You can change the package name of your code (your code names space) and will not influence the application ID and vice versa (though, however, yet, you should not change the ID of the application once published your app). However, the modification of the package name has other consequences you should know, then see the section on how to change the package name. And although the application ID looks like a traditional Java package name, the naming rules for the application ID are a little more restrictive: it must have at least two segments (one or more points). Each segment must start with a letter. All characters must be alphanumeric or underscore [A-ZAZ0-9_]. Note: the application ID used to be directly linked to the package name of your code; So some Android APIs use the term "package name" in their names of parameter methods and names, but this is actually your application ID. For example, the context.getPackageName () method returns the application ID. You don't also need to share the real name of your code package outside your app code. WARNING: If you use WebView, consider using the package name as a prefix in the application ID; Otherwise you may encounter problems as described in number 211768. Change the application ID for the default test, build tools apply an application ID to the APK instrument test using the application ID for the Variant of Build Data, added with .Test. For example, a test apk for the variant com.example.myapp.free build has the application ID com.example.myapp.free.test. Although it is not necessary, it is possible to change the application ID by defining the Test Applicationid property in your defaultBonfig or ProductFlaverFlaver block. Note: To avoid the collisions of the name with the app under test, the build tools generate the R-Class for your test APK with a namespace based on the test application ID, rather than the name of the Package defined in the manifest file. Change the package name Although the project package name corresponds to the application ID by default, you can change it. However, if you want to change the package name, keep in mind that the package name (as defined by the project directory structure) should always correspond to the package attribute in the AndroidManifest.xml file, as shown here:
