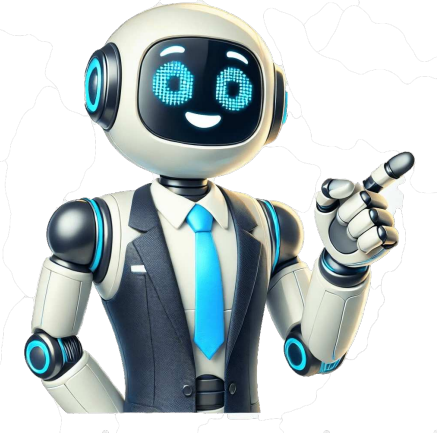


I'm not a robot
