They recite the Pathfinder pledge and law, earn the Companion reading certificate, and participate in various honors such as Drilling and Marching, Leather Craft, and Camping Skills II. The Personal Growth track focuses on building a daily devotional life, Bible study, and prayer to foster a personal relationship with Jesus. Other tracks, including Spiritual Discovery, Serving Others, Making Friends, Health and Fitness, Nature Study, and Outdoor Living, encourage Pathfinders to grow spiritually, serve others, develop friendships, prioritize health and fitness, explore nature, and perform outdoor skills. To be eligible for the Companion level, youth must be at least 11 years old or in grade 6, and actively participate in Pathfinder Club activities. This requires not only attending meetings but also completing classwork and honors, following the Pathfinder Law, and demonstrating a commitment to spiritual growth and service. The Pathfinder Pledge is an important part of the program, promoting values such as purity, kindness, truthfulness, honesty, and obedience to God's law. By understanding and living by these principles, Pathfinders can develop strong character, build meaningful relationships, and become leaders in their community. I will dedicate myself completely to God, putting His interests above all else and striving to be a faithful servant in every aspect of my life. I also promise to treat others with kindness and respect, doing unto them as I would have them do unto me.
