If this is a problem in your home, the first step is to understand what makes your dog bark too. Once you know why they're barking, you can start dealing with their problem of barking. Barking is a type of voice communication that uses dogs, and can mean different things depending on the situation. Here are some reasons why dogs bark: territorial / protective: when a person or animal enters an area your dog considers their territory, which often unleashes excessive barking. As the threat approaches, barking often becomes stronger. Your dog will look alert and even aggressive during this kind of barking. Alarm / Fear: some dogs bark at any noise or object that attracts their attention or surprises them. This can happen everywhere, not only in their homeland. Their ears will return and draw back and hidden tail when they are in a state of fear. Boredom / loneliness: dogs are packing animals. It is usually a happy bark, accompanied by tail bags and sometimes jumping. Please note: dogs often bark when they want something, how to go out, play or get a treatment. Separation anxiety / Compulsive Barking: dogs with separation anxiety often overly bark when left alone. They also usually have other symptoms, such as stimulation, destructivity. depression and inappropriate elimination. Compulsive barkers seem to bark just to listen to the sound of their voices. If you are in a fenced courtyard, use solid wood instead of chain fences. Inside, restrict access to windows and doors or cover them with a matt film. Noia/solitude: If your dog overwhelms while you're away, you need to provide more business or company to prevent it feeling lonely or bored. Bringing an outdoor dog inside will reduce the acoustic impact on neighbors and provide greater safety for your home. It is also safer, because dogs left alone outside can face thefts, thefts, poisonings, harassment and other dangers. But dogs can still f you're bored. There are a number of products on They promise to stop barking quickly. The collars that go to your dog can offer audible or ultrasonic corrections to your dog, but they are not effective on all dogs. Citronella spraying collars often work, but some dogs learn to get them out to spray and then bark at will. Shock collars, which offer a painful shock to your pet, can cause damage to pets and can make aggressive dogs, especially if they associate the person or animal the animal barking with pain. Other off-collar devices can work well if your dog barks in a set area. Water sprayers activated at bark or noise manufacturers light up when they catch barking, shooting water at your pet or emitting an irritating sound. These can sometimes break a dog to bark in a given area, but they work better if you are at home to reward your animal when it stops barking. This helps strengthen what you want your dog to do. What not to do: Do not encourage your dog to bark at some noises (a door that slams, walking people) and discourage from barking at others. Be consistent. Never use a museruola or other means of constriction to maintain a quiet dog for long periods or when they are not supervised. It can be dangerous for your pet. *Debarking is very controversial and is considered inhuman by many. It does not address the underlying cause of the bark. It is a surgical procedure in which the folds of tissue on both larynx of a dog, or the voice box, are removed, leaving dogs with a raspy bark instead of a full bark. Complications are common and can be threatening of life, including respiratory difficulties, higher stifleing accidents and ongoing pain. Dogs were also known to resume their voices after surgery.
