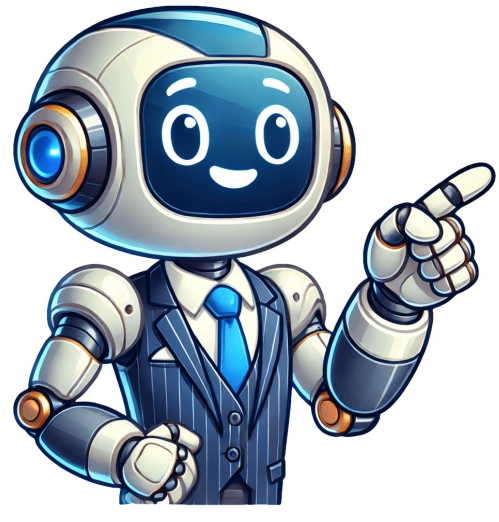

Or have you misplaced your original and require a replacement? Heres a brief overview of what marriage certificates are and where you can get a copy of them.Defining Marriage CertificateA marriage certificate is an official document that attests to the fact that you got married. It is not the same with your marriage license, which is a piece of paper issued prior to your wedding as an authorization for marriage. Following the wedding, your officiant (the person who officiated the ceremony) will return your marriage license to the county office it was issued in the first place. Your marriage certificate is issued and mailed to you by the county office. It should arrive between two and four weeks following your wedding.Marriage Certificate: What Does It Look Like?A marriage certificate is a formal-looking document that contains information about your marriage. It will contain the date, time, and place of your wedding, as well as signatures from all guests. They come in different shapes and sizes. However, the words Marriage Certificate will always be prominently displayed.Marriage Certificate: Why Does One Need It? After marriage, your marriage certificate enables you to legally change your name. The first step is to take your marriage document to the Social Security Administration and request that your name be changed on your Social Security Card. Then you can begin updating your drivers license, US passport, and personal accounts such as banks and credit cards. Without it, you cannot change your name. Many employer-sponsored benefit plans require proof of marriage in order to enroll a spouse. Lenders may need you to provide a copy of your marriage certificate to establish your marital status. The Internal Revenue Service will seek to confirm your marital status.Where Do I Get A Certified Copy of My Marriage Certificate?To obtain a certified copy of your marriage certificate, contact the county office that issued your marriage license.A certified copy is an exact replica of your original marriage certificate, which was issued directly by the county office where you obtained your marriage license.The cost of each certified copy usually is between \$5 and \$20, and the majority of offices can fulfill your request within a few working days.If you are unable to contact the county clerks office where your license was issued, you may contact the states vital records office where you were married. They will be able to assist you with obtaining a copy.The guidelines are different in every state, but every request should include:Spouses full names (at the time of marriage)Day, month, and year of the marriageMarriage location (county, city or town, and state)The purpose for requesting a certified copy of a marriage certificateDaytime telephone number (also include area code)There are any number of reasons why you may need to apply for a copy of a marriage certificate. Whether youre applying for finance or insurance policies, need proof of identity for passport and visa changes, or are applying for adoption, youll need your marriage certificate on-hand. What is a certified copy of your marriage license and do you need one?A certified copy of your marriage license is a copy of the Courts license on record. It may be necessary to show a certified copy to the appropriate entities for a legal name change, for other legitimate purposes, or for genealogical research. A certified copy does not expire. Certified copies of your marriage license cannot be obtained until your license has been filed and accepted by the County Probate Court where you obtained your license. If you would like to request a certified copy of your marriage license from the County Probate Court, you have to complete a form and pay a fee, usually \$5.In South Carolina, when you get married you are given 3 originals of your marriage license. All have the court seal imprinted on them so they are originals. You are given one copy to keep and this original is usually sufficient for all your needs. However, if you have to send your marriage license off somewhere out of your possession, you should get a certified copy. You do not want your original to get lost.You will usually need to wait one to two weeks to get a certified copy after your wedding, but it might take longer. Your wedding officiant has 15 days to send the other two completed copies of your marriage license back to the court for filing. It then takes the court a few days to actually file the license.Remember, you are not married until you exchange vows (oaths) and the marriage license is signed by all parties and returned to the court.Here are some links to the various courts to download the form you need to fill out to get a certified copy of your marriage certificate.Richland County SCLexington County SC by Heather(Pittsburgh Pa)Question: My driver's license has my married name but my passport still has my maiden name. If I have a certified copy of my marriage certificate, will I be allowed to travel like this?Answer: Ideally, your passport would have your current, legal name in it. However, you should not have any problem using a passport with your maiden name and your marriage certificate if you travel by land or sea. Contact the cruise line for verification if you plan to take a cruise.TSAs Secure Flight Program requires the name on your ticket match the name in your passport. So, you might have a problem if you plan to travel by air. Contact the airline for their recommendation. If you need to apply for a name change, there are a couple of ways to do this depending on when your passport was issued.If it has been one year or less since your passport was issued and you can provide proof of the name change, then you can submit form DS-5504 to the address on the application. There is no fee for this service.If it has been more than one year since your passport was issued and you can provide proof of the name change, then you must submit form DS-82 to the address on the application along with your most recent passport and one passport photo. The fee is \$110.Regular processing takes 4-6 weeks. You can request expedited service and get the name changed in your passport in just 2-3 weeks.
